10 PROCEDURES OF QUALIFICATION	 10.1 With allocation from ITTF, eleven (11) men and eleven (11) women will be selected from Asia by the qualification tournament in Asia to participate in the Games of the XXXI Olympiad in 2016 10.2 One (1) player from each regional zone (Central Asia, East Asia, South Asia, South East Asia and West Asia) will be qualified from the respective regional zone. Players from the five respective regions shall compete among themselves in Stage I of the tournament to determine a total of five (5) regional quota places per gender, with one from each region. 10.3 The remaining six (6) Asian Continental quota places shall be determined based on results of Stage II of the Asian qualification Tournament. 10.4 Players who took part in Stage I of the Asian Qualification event, but failed to gain one of the 5 quota places may play in Stage II of the event, with a condition that there is a maximum of two (2) players (per gender) from each Association. This maximum will be reduced to one (1) for the Association that has already gained one quota place in Stage I of the tournament. 					
11 ENTRY & ACCREDITATION	 11.1 Each Association is entitled to enter up to a maximum of four (4) men and four (4) women players. 11.2 The entry form must be returned to the Hong Kong Table Tennis Association no later than 15th February 2016 (Mon). The Organizer must be advised of any changes / substitutions no later than 15th March 2016 (Tue), after this deadline no substitution or change of player is allowed. 11.3 Copy of passport and photograph of each participant must be sent to the Organizer together with the Entry Form by following means: Email: hktta@netvigator.com Fax: +852 2838 9233

12 SYSTEM OF PLAY	Both the Men's and Women's competitions will be played in 2 Stages:			
	12.1 Stage 1 One (1) player from each regional zone (Central Asia, East Asia, South Asia, South East Asia and West Asia) will be selected from the respective regional zone.			
	Depending on the numbers of entries in each regional zone, the players will either be played by a progressive knock-out system or by a round robin system. The draw shall be conducted according to the ITTF Regulations for International Competition based on the ITTF world ranking at the time of the draw, without separation of Associations.			
	12.2 Stage 2 Six (6) Asian Continental quota places plus six (6) reserve places shall be determined. Depending on the number of entries, play will be by a direct knock-out system or a round-robin plus knock-out system to determine the top twelve positions. The draw shall be based on the ITTF world ranking at the time of the draw.			
	12.3 All matches shall be played in best of seven (7) games. 12.4 Detailed system of play is illustrated in Appendix 1 and Appendix 2.			
13 DRAW	13.1 Draw for Stage 1 is scheduled in the afternoon of 12th April 2016 (Tue).			
	13.2 Draw for Stage 2 shall be conducted after Stage 1 is completed.
